WHAT DO YOU NEED TO GET IN?

ADMISSIONS

- Visit post-secondary admissions site for admission information.
- Each program/university/college will have different admissions criteria.

CONSIDER COMPETITION FACTORS

- What 5 or 6 academic level grade 12 courses do you need?
- What marks or average do you need?
- Do you need a high school diploma?
- Will they accept multiple attempts?

COMPETITION FACTORS MAY ALSO BE BASED ON:

- portfolio,
- entrance exams,
- volunteer hours,
- references,
- personal profile,
- interviews, and more.

OTHER THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Does the university have equity admissions for Indigenous learners?
- Have you had previous post-secondary?
- Do you qualify for mature admission?

BE SURE TO HAVE MULTIPLE OPTIONS

- Many universities allow two program choices with your application.
- Consider a less competitive program as a back up plan.
- Apply to more than one post-secondary.

TAKE SUPPLEMENTARY MATERIAL SERIOUSLY

- For example:
 - › Choose relevant and related volunteer work.
 - › Diligently prepare for interviews and exams.
 - › Work hard on your portfolio.
 - › Read guidelines carefully.
